FEI HORSE AND RIDER REGISTRATION APPLICATION

1. Under the FEI Eventing Rules (Article 511.1 and 511.2), which you will find on their website www.fei.org, all horses and riders wishing to compete at any International event, **CCI or CIC, whether in Britain or Abroad, MUST** be registered with the FEI, via British Eventing.
2. It is imperative that you read and familiarise yourself with the BEF rule book which contains all up to date anti-doping regulations. This can be downloaded from the BE or BEF websites, www.britisheventing.com or www.bef.co.uk.
3. Once you have read the BEF rule book please sign and return the attached acknowledgment and agreement form for the anti-doping rules. Under the new regulations we cannot issue your FEI Registration unless we are in receipt of your signed form.
4. Riders in possession of an FEI Registration who are using any form of medication need to check the Global Drug website, reference on-line at www.globaldro.com to see whether they are required to submit a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) or Declaration of Use (DoU) to the FEI. TUE and DoU forms are available to download from the FEI website. If after checking the Global Drug website you are still unsure, please contact BE's Chief Medical Adviser, Dr Peter Whitehead, for further information - whiteheadpn@doctors.org.uk.
5. Ensure the appropriate payment is enclosed with your application. Cheques made payable to British Eventing.
6. The cost of registration is:
 - **£15.00 PER RIDER**
 - **£15.00 PER HORSE**
7. Please note that registration of both horse and rider is renewable for each calendar year.
8. All registrations must be completed prior to entry. FEI registration lists are www.fei.org updated instantly. Rider & horse numbers will come on e-mail or by post should e-mail be unavailable.
9. Every horse entered at CIC 2/1* and CCI 2/1* in a **foreign country**, and all horses entered at CIC 3* and CCI 4/3*, CCIOs, Championships, Regional and Olympic Games, whether at home or in foreign countries, must have an Official FEI Passport or a National Passport approved by the FEI, as a means of identification and to establish ownership.
10. **Horses taking part in CIC 2*/1* and CCI 2*/1* in the country in which they are resident are not required to have an FEI passport. All such horses must be properly registered with their NF and identifiable and, unless there is no national requirement for vaccination in the host country and in the country of origin, all horses must have a valid vaccination certificate.**
11. All horses competing under FEI Rules are required to be vaccinated in accordance with FEI Veterinary Regulations and Rules for Eventing. These require that booster vaccinations be given within 6 months of the first date of competition, which may be extended by 21 days in order to provide a window for re-vaccination; a shorter interval is permitted, but this will set the date for the next booster vaccination.
