## **UNAFFILIATED TEAMS OF 4 DRESSAGE CHALLENGE Including Prelim, Novice, Elementary and Medium Individual Classes**

Houghton International is one of the country's newest International Horse Trials set in the stunning surroundings of Houghton Hall in North West Norfolk.

The Houghton International Horse Trials has it all; exhilarating sporting action, spectacular setting, entertainment for young and old, plus shopping at over 70 trade stands. Set in the magnificent grounds of Houghton Hall, Norfolk, this truly is one of the most outstanding venues within the sport of eventing.

After gaining its International status in 2007, the event now hosts over 700 horses, including more than 350 International competitors. It also hosts the only British leg of the FEI Nations Cup which sees teams from all over the world battle it out across 7 events

Organised by Musketeer Event Management, the event is delivered by Alec Lochore (Event Director). Having experience as an event rider, FEI course designer, technical delegate, international consultant and most recently the eventing manager at the London Olympic Games, the knowledge and skills used to deliver this event are incomparable.

Alec Lochore has kindly agreed for the previous 5 consecutive years to allow grassroots Dressage riders to opportunity to compete at a major event on their own terms. The young riders use the same Dressage Areas as the International 3DE and have the opportunity to soak up the atmosphere and enjoy an Unaffiliated Dressage event with all the benefits of a larger event – great shopping, great atmosphere and some wonderful support from our nation's most prestigious riders

**By Road** - Houghton is situated 1/2 a mile off the A148 to the north, 10 miles east of Kings Lynn and is extensively sign posted during the event. There will be specific entrances and exits during the event so please adhere to these. Travel Times - Cambridge 1 hour, Peterborough 50 minutes, Norwich 40 minutes

# Class 1: Teams of 4 Dressage Challenge

Estimated start time: 10:00

Each Team will consist of 4 Riders

Each of the following tests will be ridden – P13 (2006), N30 (2006), N23 (2012) and E40 (2010)  
3 Highest Scores will count to the Team total. In the event of a tie, the 4<sup>th</sup> Riders score will count

The highest placed 10 Riders in each of the above 4 tests will also qualify for Individual Placings

**Event will be restricted to 16 Teams of 4**

The first 8 will be on a first come first serve basis, the last 8 places will be balloted.

Maximum of 2 entries per Club (unless unallocated places are available)

## Class 1a: Individual Entries to Tests within Class 1

Start times: Indls will run at the end of the Team Entries

## Class 2: P17a (2017) – Long Arena Format

Start times: Are entirely dependant on entries, therefore unknown at time of Schedule

**Restriction** = Prelim Horses must have 0 BD Points

**NOTE: Times may not support the use of this as a Warm Up Class and it should not be used as such**

## Class 3: M69 (2005) – Long Arena Format

Start times: Are entirely dependant on entries, therefore unknown at time of Schedule

**Restriction** = Medium Horses may have a maximum of 299 BD Points

**NOTE: Times may not support the use of this as a Warm Up Class and it should not be used as such**

### KEY RULE INFORMATION:

- Prelim Horses may not have any BD Points, Novice Horses a max of 124, Elem Horses a max of 199 and Medium Horses a max of 299
  - Any Team changes must be notified to the Entry Secretary immediately
    - Tack and Dress Rules are as per BRC Guidelines
    - The Judges Decision is final and there is no right of appeal
      - All other rules as per BRC Rules valid for 2016
  - Each Team will nominate 1 Helper (Entry may be refused without confirmation of volunteer)
    - BRC Membership Cards are **not** required at Declaration
